

**J.R. ALEXANDER** *Central Missouri* **6-0 220 OLB**

Transfer from Memphis. Knack for the big play. Things happen when he is involved with the ball-carrier. 2016 Stats: 34 tackles, 6.5 TFLs, 5.0 sacks, 2 QBH, 2 FF.

**MYLES ALEXANDER** *Findlay* **6-1 230 OLB**

Appeared and started in 10 games. Named honorable mention all-GLIAC. Led the Oilers with 101 tackles. Had four sacks. Led the team with 10.5 tackles for loss. Forced two fumbles and recovered one. Had season-high 13 tackles on Oct. 1 and Oct. 8.

**ALEX ARMAH** *West Georgia* **6-2 235 OLB TE**

Was a First Team All-GSC selection for the second-straight year and he joins a select group of players who have been named All-Gulf South Conference in three seasons. Armah's distinction goes a step further this season, as he was also named Second Team All-GSC as a tight end, becoming the first player in conference history to be named All-Conference as an offensive and a defensive player. Armah was a Second Team defensive end as a sophomore in 2014, then has been First Team as an end as a junior and senior.

**ZACH BARNES** *West Liberty* **6-2 245 OLB DE**

A playmaking undersized DE. Nose for the ball and attacking ball-handlers behind the line. 2016 Stats: 38 tackles, 11 TFLs, 3.5 sacks, PBU, 3 QBHs, 5 FR, FF.

**TREVIN BIGLOW** *Harding* **6-1 240 OLB**

2nd Team All-American as a DE. Great American Conference Defensive Player of the Year. He had 42 tackles, including 19.0 tackles for loss and 7.5 sacks. Biglow was second at Harding with 24.5 career sacks and third with 43.5 tackles for loss.

**ZACHARY BLAIR** *Virginia-Wise* **6-2 215 OLB ILB**

For the second consecutive season has been named to the Conference Commissioner's Association (CCA) 2nd Team All-American, All-Super Region I First Team, named the Commonwealth's Small College Linebacker of the Year by the Richmond Times Dispatch for the second consecutive year. Capped his collegiate career by becoming NCAA Division II's all-time leader in tackles for loss with 80 while once again leading UVa-Wise and the Mountain East Conference with 21 TFLs this season. Also an All-MEC First-Team selection, led UVa-Wise in tackles with 87, sacks with five and blocked kicks with two. Blair also picked off a pair of passes, returning one 82 yards for a touchdown against West Virginia State.

**AARON BOHL** *MSU-Moorhead* **6-0 226 OLB**

2nd Team All-NSIC. Was a four-year starter at linebacker and a three-year team captain. He finished third on the team with 71 tackles and second on the team with 37 assisted tackles. Bohl also had 4.5 sacks and 7.5 tackles for loss along with two fumble recoveries.

**JAMEL BRINTLEY** *Mars Hill* **6-2 225 OLB**

All-SAC Second Team DE. Tied fir team lead in tackles. Solid tackler and pass rusher. Could play inside with some added weight. 2016 Stats: 70 tackles, 3.5 sacks, 9.5 TFLs, PBU.

**CHRIS BROCKMAN** *Colorado School of Mines* **5-11 225 OLB**

Transfer from Lafayette where he was named the team's linebacker MVP in 2014. In 2016 was named Honorable Mention All-RMAC and RMAC First-Team All-Academic. Brockman led the team with 79 tackles from the outside, generating a team-best 10.0 TFL and 4.5 sacks. The graduate transfer had a pick, two break-ups, and four hurries in his one and only season with the Orediggers.

**JOSEPH BRYANT** *Cheney* **6-0 245 OLB**

A three-time All-PSAC East honoree who was named to the first-team in the PSAC East in 2016, and earned first-team accolades from the ECAC in 2016. Earned second-team All-PSAC East accolades in 2014 and 15, moved all along the D-line in 2016, to register career-highs in solo tackles with 32, tackles for a loss with 12 and sacks with four. Bryant ends his Cheney career, having played in 43 games, with 169 total tackles, 33.5 for a loss, 10 sacks, two pass break ups, two forced fumbles, three fumble recoveries and one fumble recovery returned for a touchdown.

**CAMERON BUELL** *Humboldt State* **6-4 260 OLB**

Two-time 2nd Team All-GNC (2015-2014). Team's leading tackler both years. Was second leading tackler for the Jacks in 2016 with 61,8 were for a loss with 2 sacks. Also had 2 PBUs, 5 QBHs and 2 FR.

**KEVIN CHAPPLE** *Lock Haven* **5-11 226 OLB ILB**

All-Region, All-PSAC. Led the Bald Eagles on defense. He finished his one season with LHU with 96 tackles. At the end of the regular season his 8.7 tackles per game were sixth most in the PSAC (2nd most in PSAC East) and his 63 solo stops ranked second in the PSAC, and 24th in the NCAA. Chapple added 16.5 tackles for loss (4th PSAC) and 5.5 sacks. Chapple finished his DII career (44 games) with 1.47 TFLs per game, which ranked among the top-three among all active DII players. Chapple was nominated for the Cliff Harris Award, nation's top small college defensive player.

**KEVIN CLARKE** *IUP* **6-0 215 OLB**

Received All-Super Region One honors by the Don Hansen Football Gazette. The senior captain led the PSAC, ranked third in the region, and 17th in Division II with 10.9 tackles per game. He finished the year with 109 stops in 10 games, 6.0 tackles-for-loss, three interceptions – including one returned for a touchdown – and four more pass breakups. Also earned first team All-Super Region One honors from the Conference Commissioners Association and was a three-time All-PSAC West selection.

**TYLER CONDIT** *New Haven* **6-0 242 OLB**

A finalist for the Cliff Harris Award. Finished his final campaign with the Blue and Gold with 117 tackles, becoming just the second player in school history to record at least 100 tackles in three seasons. Overall for his career, Condit racked up 452 tackles, breaking a program record that Eric Lesinski held for nearly 30 years. In addition to this honor, Condit was named the New Haven Gridiron Club Defensive Player of the Year after also earning NCAA Division II CCA All-Super Region 1 Second Team accolades. He was also named to the NE10 First Team All-Conference for the second straight season.

**VALORIAN CUNNINGHAM** *Wayne State (MI)* **6-2 220 OLB**

2016: Served as one of the team captains. Earned First Team All-GLIAC honors. Voted WSU's Defensive Most Valuable Player. Also received the Ron Solack #35 Award for wearing his Wayne State uniform with unmatched pride and playing the game with enthusiasm. Started all 11 games at outside linebacker. Finished fourth on the team in solo tackles (33), tied-for-second in both assisted tackles (19) and quarterback hurries (3), second in both total tackles (52) and tackles for loss (7.0 / 5 solo, 4 assisted), tied-for-first in interceptions and first among non-defensive backs in pass break-ups, (4) and totaled 2.5 sacks (2 solo, 1 assisted). Played in 40 career games, making 27 starts. Concluded his career with 169 tackles (107-62), including 19.5 for loss (14 solo, 11 assisted), totaled 8.5 sacks (6 solo, 5 assisted) and was tied-for-30th in sack yards (47), tied-for-third with nine quarterback hurries (since statistic started being kept in 2002) and finished tied-for-fourth in career blocked kicks with three. Also had 12 passes defended (10 break-ups plus two interceptions).

**RYAN DAHLEEN** *MSU-Moorhead* **6-2 249 OLB**

Had a strong season from his defensive end position. He finished with a team-high 8.5 sacks, which was tied for fourth in the NSIC, and led the team with 13 tackles for loss. Dahleen also had a blocked kick. He was A 2ND Team All-NSIC after an honorable mention honoree in 2013.

**ANTHONY DARKANGELO** *Ferris State* **6-0 232 OLB**

First-team All-America accolades for the first time in his collegiate career. A team captain, Darkangelo was the leader of a FSU defensive unit that ranked among the league's best. He totaled a team-high and career-best 143 total stops in 2016 with 62 solo tackles and 81 assisted hits. He also recorded 11 tackles for loss resulting in -17 yards and had a sack along with a forced fumble. The first-team all-conference choice was a four-year letterwinner and key contributor in the Bulldogs' success over his collegiate career.

**JOSH DAVIS** *Henderson State* **5-11 215 OLB**

Earned first-team All-GAC honors for the third straight year. The senior outside linebacker compiled a season-best 12 tackles against Oklahoma Baptist. Davis finished his career at Henderson with 296 total tackles and 31.5 tackles for lost yardage.

**SIE DOE, JR.** *Fort Hays* **6-1 230 OLB**

Don Hansen All-Super Region 3 Team. Adds another honor to his long list accumulated for the 2016 season. The senior was also an All-Super Region 3 First Team pick by the D2CCA and named its Defensive Player of the Year. Doe has already been tabbed an All-America First Team selection by the AFCA, D2CCA, and Associated Press. Doe was also the MIAA Defensive Player of the Year, finishing the year with 15 sacks, 19.5 tackles for loss, 81 tackles overall, and five forced fumbles.

**DYLAN DONAHUE** *West Georgia* **6-3 240 OLB**

2016 Gulf South Conference Defensive Player of the Year as an undersized DE. In 2015, Donahue led the league with 12 sacks en route to a first team all-conference selection. This season, the senior increased his production and tied the league record with 13.5 sacks. His 13.5 sacks ranked sixth in the nation, and his 20 tackles for loss ranked 12th nationally. He also earned First Team All-GSC in both seasons at UWG.

**ROB DURY Indianapolis 6-2 220 OLB**

Cliff Harris Award nominee voted Don Hansen All-America Second Team. Garnered his third career All-GLVC First Team honor and also named All-Super Region 4 Second Team. Compiled 125 total tackles on the season, ranking sixth in Division II in tackles per game (11.4), ranked seventh in D-II in fumbles forced (3). Finished collegiate career with 392 tackles, good for sixth on UIndy's all-time list. Voted one of only two team captains.

**RAY EDWARDS Wingate 6-1 225 OLB**

As a DE, NCAA Division II All-America second team, All-Super Region 2 team, and the first Bulldog in program history to earn South Atlantic Conference Defensive Player of the Year laurels. Has a motor which absolutely does not stop. The first team All-SAC honoree ranked second in the conference with 7.5 total sacks and 17.5 tackles for a loss of 75 yards to cap a tremendous senior campaign. He was third on the Bulldog defensive charts with 56 total tackles, adding one interception, four forced fumbles with a fumble recovery and nine quarterback hurries to his defensive ledger.

**GEO FEGGINS Virginia State 6-1 220 OLB**

HBCU D-II All-American, All-CIAA First Team. Very good LB with sure-tackling skills and great instincts. 2016 Stats: 96 tackles, 15.5 TFLs, 4.5 sacks, PBU, FR, 3QBHs.

**DEMETRIS FORD Arkansas Tech 6-2 259 OLB DE**

Picked up his second consecutive all-GAC honor after registering 42 tackles on the season. Had 8.5 tackles for losses totaling 53 yards, and 5.0 sacks on the year, while forcing a pair of fumbles.

**DEONATE GARY Central State 6-1 225 OLB**

2nd Team HBCU All-American and a back-to-back All-SIAC First Team selection, finished the year with 106 tackles, giving him back-to-back 100 tackle seasons. The 6'1" linebacker from Lakeland, Florida averaged 10.6 tackles per game which ranked No. 21 in NCAA Div. II. He also led the Marauders with 4 sacks, 10 tackles for a loss and 3 forced fumbles.

**MATTHEW GAWLIK Gannon 6-3 240 OLB**

Named to the College Sports Information CoSIDA Academic All-America football first team for the third consecutive season WHILE leading Gannon in sacks (7.5) and ranked third in tackles for a loss (9.5). Gawlik's senior resume included 34 tackles (13 solo), one forced fumble and two blocked kicks. He ranks fifth all-time at Gannon with 17 career sacks. Gawlik produced 103 tackles during his four-year career.

**DARYL GEORGE Tuskegee 6-0 242 OLB ILB**

College DE who actually had a better season than 2015 when he was named Second Team All-SIAC. 2016 Stats: 35 tackles, 9.5 TFLs, 7.5 sacks, 3 QBHs.

**DAMON GOLDHAMMER** *Black Hills State* **6-2 230 OLB**

Solid LB with good instincts; especially in pass coverage. 2016 Stats: 56 tackles, 8.5 TFLs, sack, 2 INTs (TD), 3 PBU, 2 QBH, 2 FR, blocked kick.

**TRAVIS GROVES** *Black Hills State* **6-3 220 OLB**

Honorable Mention RMAC. ranks seventh in the league with 90 tackles for an average of 8.2 per game. Groves also intercepted two passes and had eight pass breakups as a linebacker.

**TRENT HANNAH** *S.E. Oklahoma* **6-2 225 OLB**

Outside linebacker tallied 26 tackles on the season over 10 games, but played havoc on opposing backfields where he recorded 8.5 tackles for loss to lead the Storm and turned in a team-best 4.5 sacks for a loss of 20 yards. He also added a QB hurry and a forced fumble.

**ANDREW HARRIS** *Bloomsburg* **5-10 215 OLB**

1st Team All-PSAC. Became the first Bloomsburg player since 2014 to finish the season with at least 100 tackles as he closed out his collegiate career with a career-high 103 stops (54 solo) to lead the team. He ended the season third in the PSAC in total tackles and fourth in the conference in tackles per game (9.4). He led the team with three forced fumbles and was second, or tied for second, in both tackles for a loss (7.0) and interceptions (2). He finished his career with 265 total tackles and 18.5 tackles for a loss.

**VICTOR HUDSON** *Edinboro* **6-1 230 OLB**

Named to the HERO Sports D2 Football 2016 All-America Team. The undersized defensive end was named to the second team. This comes after he was previously named to the Associated Press Little All-America Third Team. He was also a second team D2CCA Super Region 1 selection and All-PSAC West first team honoree. Played a major role in Edinboro's incredible turnaround campaign. Had a breakout season following a move from outside linebacker to defensive end. He finished with 67 tackles, good for fourth on the team. His specialty was plays behind the line of scrimmage. Hudson broke school's record for tackles for loss with 24, and also led the Scots with 11.5 sacks. He was twice named the PSAC West Defensive Player of the Week. He led the team with three fumble recoveries and added an interception.

**RUEBEN IBARRA** *Minnesota State* **6-0 240 OLB ILB**

Was named the team's Linebacker of the Year and to the All-NSIC Second Team as well. Started all 11 games for the Mavericks this past season. Ibarra led MSU with 92 tackles, to go along with seven tackles for a loss and 3.5 sacks. Ibarra recorded more than 10 tackles in three games last season, including a season-high 13 against Bemidji State.

**RALPH JONATHAS** *New Haven* **6-2 230 OLB**

Undersized DE was not a starter but is a good athlete who could succeed as a linebacker. Coachable and smart with a can-do attitude. 2016 Stats: 23 tackles, 4.5 TFLs, 3.0 sacks, FR.

**KEELAN JONES** *Shaw* **6-4 220 OLB**

Had A monster senior year, earning him second all-conference honor. Jones led the league in tackles per game (10.6), 95 total tackles, 14 tackle for losses, four pass breakups, one block, a sack and an interception.

**MATTHEW KING** *Colorado School of Mines* **6-3 245 OLB ILB**

As a DE, King was one of Mines' most disruptive players in opponents' backfields as he put together 7.5 TFL and 4.5 sacks on 18 tackles with six hurries. Honorable Mention All-RMAC.

**NICHOLAS KING** *Walsh* **6-1 230 OLB**

All-GLIAC Second Team. One of the best linebackers in the conference with 109 tackles, third-most in the GLIAC. His 68 assists were second in the conference and 9.9 tackles per game were also third at the end of the regular season. His 74-yard fumble return for a touchdown against Wayne State was the longest scoring play of the season for the Cavaliers. King also reached double digits in tackles in five games this season, with season-highs of 15 against Tiffin and Ashland.

**MITCH KNUTSON** *St. Cloud State* **6-3 245 OLB**

Honorable Mention All-NSIC selection as a DE after earning Second Team honors as a junior. Knutson played in 10 games with nine starts. He led all defensive lineman on the team with his 6.5 stops for loss and four sacks, while also totaling 29 tackles.

**TYKE KOZEAL** *Nebraska-Kearney* **6-0 240 OLB**

D2 Football Second-team , AP Little and D2 CCA (first-team) and AFCA (second-team) All-American. Despite logging 604 tackles in his career, second most in NCAA history (all divisions), this is the first time Kozeal was named an All-American. Recorded an NCAA-best 174 tackles this past season. Besides his tackle total, Kozeal had two forced fumbles, two fumble recoveries and a 16-yard interception return for a score to seal a 47-32 win over Central Oklahoma.

**JORDAN LARDANI** *California University of Pennsylvania* **6-2 230 OLB**

2nd Team All-PSAC West as he set career highs in every category this season and ranks among the top five in the PSAC with 16.0 TFL, 9.5 sacks and three forced fumbles.

**TANNER LOPEZ** *Northern State* **6-4 240 OLB**

NSIC North Division second team. Started all 11 games for the Wolves at defensive end. The senior notched 35 tackles including 12 solo and 23 assisted. He also added 5.5 tackles for a total loss of 30 yards including 4.5 sacks. Lopez was tied for second on the team with two interceptions, while adding two pass break-ups.

**WADEL LOUIS** *Lincoln (PA)* **6-3 240 OLB ILB**

Senior leader on defense during tough season for team. 2015 Stats: 52 tackles, 1.5 sacks, 2.5 TFLs, 2 PBU.

**MORGAN LLOYD** *Tiffin University* **6-3 220 OLB**

Collected his second honorable mention All-GLIAC selection in as many seasons. Loyd finished this season with 57 tackles, 4.0 tackles for loss, 2.0 sacks, and an interception.

**NATHAN LUCS** *Sioux Falls* **6-0 220 OLB**

Lucs, a two-year starter, has received his first-ever All-NSIC recognition with his honorable mention selection. Lucs has recorded 42 tackles, including 24 solo stops, 5.5 TFLs, 2.5 sacks, two forced fumbles with a pass breakups this season on USF defense, which has allowed just 45 points in the final four games and is ranked second in total defense. Lucs has registered 109 career tackles, including 65 solo stops in 40 games. He has 5.5 TFLs and 5.5 sacks in his career along with three forced fumbles and two pass breakups.

**JULIAN MORGAN** *Tuskegee* **6-2 225 OLB**

HBCU Gameday Division II All-American team 2nd team selection as DE. First Team All-SIAC selection - finished the year with 39 total tackles, including 17 solo tackles. He finished with 6.5 tackles for loss, including 3.5 sacks on the season - finishing his career with 22.5 sacks in three years at Tuskegee. Morgan also finished with four quarterback hurries, one pass breakup and a blocked kick.

**DARIAN MORRIS** *Northeastern State* **6-3 215 OLB**

Two-time All-MIAA selection (2016, 2015 Honorable Mention). In just 8 games with 7 starts in 2016, he tallied 58 tackles, 2.5 TFLs, a sack, 1.0, 3 PBU's, and a fumble recovery.

**ALEX OLSON** *West Texas A&M* **6-0 233 OLB ILB**

Honorable Mention All-LSC. Put the finishing touches on a career in which he played in 46 games with 16 starts. Finished the season with 55 tackles, 33 solo stops, four tackles for loss, two hurries and two forced fumbles. For his career, Olson recorded 157 tackles, 66 solo, 12.5 tackles for loss for 30 yards, two sacks for 10 yards, six hurries, two pass breakups, two forced fumbles and three fumble returns.

**KEVIN PHARAON** *West Virginia Wesleyan* **6-0 225 OLB ILB**

Undersized DE who was 2016 All-MEC First Team and nominated for the Cliff Harris Award. Led the Bobcats in tackles with 77. He also made his mark nationally as he was tied for 17th in total sacks with 10.5 and 17th in sacks per game (0.94). He was fourth in the Mountain East Conference in sacks and 16th in tackles per game.

**JOHN REED** *Adams State* **6-0 225 OLB**

Honorable Mention RMAC. For a large portion of the season, Reed led the RMAC in tackles. His season started strong with 14 tackles against Black Hills State. He ultimately concluded 2016 with a team-high 91 tackles which ranks 4th at the RMAC level. Eclipsed 10 or more tackles in 5 games while his 3 forced fumbles ties him for second amongst RMAC players. His 4 sacks served as a team-high.

**KOLE SCHANKIE** *Emporia State* **6-1 217 OLB**

2016 Don Hansen Football Committee All-Super Region Three Team. Led the MIAA and was ranked third in the nation with seven interceptions. The seven interceptions are ranked fourth on the Emporia State single season list. He had a team best 81 tackles on the season.

**ALEX SCHMIDTBERGER** *Fort Hays* **6-2 220 OLB**

Earned the first All-Super Region honor of his career. The senior was a second-team selection at linebacker after posting a team-best 143 tackles with 1.5 sacks and 4.5 tackles for loss. Schmidtberger finished second all-time in tackles for the NCAA Division II era at FHSU with 353, just eight shy of the record.

**TRAVON SPENCER** *Kentucky State* **6-1 224 OLB**

Strong tackling All-SIAC LB. Teams leading tackler who is good in coverage as well. 2016 Stats: 107 tackles, 7.5 TFLs, sack, 2 FF, FR, INT, 3 PBU.

**RHAKEEM STALLINGS** *Charleston* **6-1 225 OLB**

2016 & 2015 All-MEC First Team. Talented defender who shows abilities in all aspects of the defense. Teams leading tackler who is solid when called on to pass defend or rush the passer. 2016 Stats: 117 tackles, 11 TFLs, 3 sacks, 2 INTs, 2 PBU, 7 QBH, FF, FR.

**CHRIS STAPLETON** *Florida Tech* **5-11 220 OLB**

Selected All-American; the first for the linebacker. Led team in tackles with 90. Ranked second in the GSC in tackles with 8.2 per game, registering 6.0 tackles for loss, 2.0 sacks and a pair of interceptions in 2016.

**TAFATOLU TAFI** *Western Oregon* **6-2 240 OLB**

Earned first-time all-league selections with A solid season. Tafai finished third on the team with 62 overall tackles while breaking up two passes, forcing a fumble and recovering another during the season.

**DAVID TALLEY** *Grand Valley State* **6-2 230 OLB**

2016: 1st Team All-GLIAC. Third on the squad in total tackles with 57 (29 solo/28 assisted), fifth in tackles for loss with 7.0 (-35) and fourth in QB sacks with 3.5 (-23). Talley also has two interceptions and six pass deflections. He is GVSU's leading active tackler with 266 stops, 28,0 tackles for loss and 10.5 QB sacks. 2015: Honorable mention All-GLIAC. Led the Lakers in total tackles with 98 stops and 8.0 TFLs.

**JUSTIN TAYLOR** *Lindenwood* **6-1 236 OLB**

2015: Honorable mention all-MIAA. Finished second on the team with 11.0 TFLs, and was 3rd with 4.0 sacks.

**JAY TERRY** *West Virginia State* **6-4 230 OLB DE**

Undersized for a DE but has great stature for OLB. Proven pass rusher and strong tackler. 2016 Stats: 53 tackles, 6.5 sacks, 2 FF, FR, 3 QBH, 2 PBU.

**OCTAVIUS THOMAS** *Shepherd* **5-9 218 OLB ILB**

2016 1st Team All-Super Region One. What do you do with a hard-nosed, tough, tackling machine who is this small. Would exceed for sure as a special teamer. Paced the Rams in total tackles (108) and solo stops (76). He added 11.0 tackles-for-loss (-39 yards) and 5.5 sacks (-31 yards). Thomas also had three forced fumbles, a pair of fumble recoveries, a pass breakup, and an interception.

**JONATHAN THROPAY** *Azusa Pacific* **6-4 224 OLB**

All-GNAC Honorable Mention. Moved from WR to CB to LB in 2015 where he excelled. Named 1st team All-GNAC in 2015. 2016 Stats: 55 tackles, 3 TFLs, INT, PBU, 2 QBHs.

**JACOB VOLLSTEDT** *N.W. Missouri* **6-2 215 OLB**

Named the 2016 Don Hansen Division II co-Defensive Player of the Year. Led the team with a career-high 140 tackles last season. He had 25.0 tackles for loss, seven sacks, three forced fumbles, two blocked kicks and a fumble recovery. He was also named to the D2CCA All-America and D2Football.com All-America first team. 2015: 1st team All-MIAA, MIAA Academic honor roll, CCA all-region 2nd team. Finished year with 122 tackles, 17.0 tackles for loss and 13.0 sacks.

**ALTON VOSS** *Grand Valley State* **6-3 240 OLB**

Was a four-year standout for the Lakers as an undersized DE on the gridiron, appearing the NCAA DII Playoffs three times, including a pair of trips to the NCAA DII semifinals and a GLIAC Championships in 2016. **JOE WETTY** *Bloomsburg* **6-3 235 OLB ILB**

All-PSAC 2nd Team. Started all 11 games on the defensive line and finished fifth on the team with a career-high 43 total tackles (19 solo) in his final season with the Huskies. He added three tackles for a loss, two quarterback sacks, and was second on the team with seven quarterback pressures. He recorded at least one tackle in all 11 contests and had multiple tackles in ten of those contests. The redshirt senior closed out his career with 115 total tackles, 21 tackles for a loss, and 16 quarterback sacks.

**DARIUS WRIGHT** *North Alabama* **6-0 228 OLB**

A transfer to UNA this season from East Carolina, was All-Region and first-team All-GSC. He is third on the team with 50 stops and has six tackles for loss of nine yards, one quarterback sack and four pass break-ups.

**ANTHONY ZAPPONE** *Slippery Rock* **6-2 240 OLB**

A second team All-PSAC West honoree. Transferred For his senior year from Eastern Michigan, was among the top linebackers in the conference this year and led Slippery Rock in tackles. He finished the year with 88 total stops, including 10.5 tackles for loss and 5.5 sacks. He also picked off a team-high five passes and returned one for a touchdown in the last game of the year. Zappone was also credited with three additional pass breakups, seven QB hurries and one forced fumble on the year.
