**WISCONSIN-STEVEN'S POINT**

**6-4 340 OC/OG**

2017: Honorable Mention All-WIAC. Helped power the Pointers' offensive line that racked up 347.7 yards per game of total offense. UWSP ran for more than 100 yards in five games, including a season-high 277 rushing yards against Adrian.

## **JACOB HEATON**

**BRIDGEWATER (VA)**

**6-3 280 OC/**

2017: Completed his second year as BC's starting center. 2016: 3rd Team All-ODAC. Started all 10 games at center. Earned All-Conference honors after playing 89% of the snaps and ranking second on the team in knockdowns.

## **ALEX HELM**

**HOBART**

**6-3 300 OC/OG**

Helped the Statesmen gain a league-leading 4,236 yards and score 44 touchdowns. Hobart averaged 423.6 yards per game. Earned all-conference honors for the second straight year.

## **STEPHEN MCGRATH**

**OHIO WESLEYAN**

**6-5 325 OC/OT**

Three year starter at guard, tackle and center. Helped anchor a Bishop offensive line that

helped the team average 335.9 yards per game and compile 22 touchdown passes, one short of the school record.

**PATRICK MOHORCIC**                      **WOOSTER**  
**6-5 285 OC/OT**

Three-year starter on the line. In 2016, shifted from right tackle to center. 2017: 2nd Team All-NCAC. Helped lead the way for an offense ranked first in the NCAC in yards per game (456.3), first downs (241), and second in scoring offense (37.8) - three stats where Wooster sits in the top 35 nationally in the latest Div. III statistical rankings report.

**TYLER ROLLAND**                      **CARLETON (MN)**  
**6-3 359 OC/**

Team had the second-most pass attempts (350) in the MIAC this season, but thanks in part to the work of Rolland, the Knights were sacked a conference-low 12 times. Additionally, Carleton committed only 39 penalties on the year, easily the fewest in the conference and the fifth-lowest total among NCAA Division III teams to play a full 10-game schedule. 2016: All-MIAC Honorable Mention.

**6-5 325 OG/**

Starting guard with good size and experience.

---

**JACOB ALFORD**                      **LOUISIANA COLLEGE**  
**6-3 308 OG/**

A three-year starter on the Wildcat offensive line, Alford earned his first ASC postseason honor. He was a key part of an offensive line that only surrendered 17 sacks all season, paved the way for 1,397 rushing yards, and provided protection for 3,170 passing yards.

**GEOFF BELL**                      **ITHACA**

**6-2 290 OG/**

2017: 1st Team All-Liberty. Started all 10 games for the Bombers, helped lead the offense to 370.7 total yards per game, including 114.9 on the ground and 255.8 through the air. This is the first time since 2014 that Ithaca has totaled over 300 yards of offense per game and the most overall since 2008.

**RICKEY BENSON**                      **DEAN**

**6-4 359 OG/**

2017: Helped anchor an offensive line that paved the way for Bulldog ball carriers to average 154 yards per game, good for fourth in the league. Overall, Dean finished fourth in the ECFC with over 1,500 yards rushing.

**RYAN BOWMAN**                      **WILKES**

**6-2 310 OG/**

For his career, Bowman played and started in all but one game on the offensive line for Wilkes. Named Second Team All-MAC as a senior in 2017, Honorable Mention All-MAC as a sophomore in 2015 and as a junior in 2016.

**CAMDEN COTTER**                      **CARTHAGE**

**6-3 285 OG/**

Was a key part of the Red Men offensive line in 2017, as the right tackle started eight games this season earning 2nd Team All-CCIW honors.

---

**GREG CYBULSKI**                      **LORAS**

**6-8 340 OG/OT**

2017: Honorable Mention All-IIAC. Had 25 straight starts as a member of the offensive line, racking up 105 career knockdowns and 10 career cuts. This season, Cybulski aided the Duhawk ground game that totaled 1,359 yards and 19 touchdowns while holding opposing defenses to 10 sacks all season.

**6-4 320 OG/**

2017: With his 1st Team selection, became the second Castleton player ever to earn either First Team or Second Team All-ECFC honors in four straight seasons. 2016: Selected ECFC Second-Team All-Conference. 2015: Named to New England Football Writers Division II/III All-New England Team, Named ECFC Offensive Lineman of the Year, Selected to ECFC All-Conference First Team. 2014: Selected to the ECFC All-Conference Second Team.

**GRANT HAFFENDEN**                      **ST. LAWRENCE**

**6-6 290 OG/OT**

Good-sized lineman with room for bulk. Earned starting assignments early culminating in senior year starting role.

---

**CHASE HUDSON**                      **GEORGE FOX**

**6-5 285 OG/**

2017: Another lineman for the Bruins to make the All-NWC team as an honorable mention. Hudson was crucial for the Bruins on the line, as he finishes his career with 33 games played.

---

**THOMAS KORWAN**                      **SUNY-MARITIME**

**6-2 290 OG/**

2017: Honored as ECFC Offensive Lineman of the Year after his impressive senior campaign. Korwan anchored a Privateers offense that led the league in passing yards with 2,547 (nearly 500 more yards than the next best passing performance). Maritime's 20 passing touchdowns and 254.7 yards per game were also league highs. Led by Korwan, the Maritime offense was nearly unstoppable in the red zone as well. Their 47-56 scores in red zone (84%) led the ECFC.

**6-8 335 OG/OT**

2017: 2nd Team All-MIAC. Massive lineman. Helped the Tommie's balanced offense average more than 47 points a game and score 75 offensive TDs, tied with the Oklahoma Sooners for third most among all 660 NCAA teams.

**SCOTT MCCOMBS****HAMPDEN-SYDNEY****6-3 285 OG/**

2017: Helped anchor the Tigers' offensive line that helped the team average 400 yards-per-game, including 79.2 on the ground, to go with 29.3 points-per-game.

**SAM MEADS****OBERLIN****6-3 320 OG/**

Two-year starter. Member of Track & Field Team in Shot Put and Weight Throw.

---

**RILEY OWENS****HARDIN-SIMMONS****6-3 300 OG/**

2017: 1st Team All-ASC. 2015: Named honorable mention all-ASC.

---

**COLIN REESE****WESTMINSTER (PA)****6-4 310 OG/**

2017: Earned the first All-PAC First Team nod of his career, played in an integral part in Westminster's rushing attack which averaged 217.6 yards per contest, good for third in the league. The Titans' 24 rushing touchdowns tied for third-best in the league. Reese also played a pivotal role in Westminster allowing the second fewest sacks in the conference (12). Reese was named Honorable Mention in 2016. Transfer from UCalifornia (PA).

**DONNIE RYDZEWSKI****WISCONSIN-PLATTEVILLE****6-3 295 OG/**

2017: Third Team All-Region offense honors. The guard started all 10 games and anchored a Pioneers' offensive line that gave up only 19 sacks all season. A two-time All-WIAC selection, this was the senior's first All-Region selection.

**MITCHELL SCHAUER****WISCONSIN-WHITewater****6-3 285 OG/**

2017: All-WIAC 2nd Team. Helped the team finish second in the league in rushing offense (172.3 ypg) and third in red zone offense (73.5 percent). The Warhawks averaged 23.0 points per game.

---

**KEVIN SHEEHAN****AMHERST****6-4 290 OG/**

2017: NESCAC First Team Offense, with the senior guard leading the Amherst offensive line corps, Sheehan proved to be a key component of an Amherst run game that led the league in rushing touchdowns (20) and accumulated 1,607 rushing yards, averaging 178.6 yards per game on the ground.

**LOGAN THIELE****MONMOUTH****6-5 315 OG/**

2017: All-MWC South Division 1st Team. Blocked for an offense that churned out over 400 yards – more than 200 on the ground – and 37 points per game.

---

**DAN VIERECK****WIDENER****6-6 347 OG/**

2017: Helped to anchor an offensive line that has allowed just 20 sacks this season. 2016: Honorable mention All-MAC.

---

**CONNOR WAGNER****CONCORDIA(WI)****6-3 290 OG/OT**

Three-year starter. 2017: Named All-Northern Athletics Collegiate Conference First Team. Appeared in and started all 10 games. Helped the Falcons offense average 329.4 total offensive yards per game. CUW finished with 2,061 passing yards and 14 touchdowns, while rushing for 1,233 yards and seven touchdowns. 2016: All-Northern Athletics Collegiate Conference First Team.

**CHRISTIAN WALSH**                      **FROSTBURG STATE**

**6-4 280 OG/**

2017: 1st Team All-American. A stalwart along the Bobcat offensive line, making 43 career starts and leading an offensive unit that paced the NJAC in scoring offense (36.0), first downs (276) and third down conversions (46.6) in 2017. Frostburg racked up the numbers offensively this season with a school-record 468 points scored with 40 or more points in four different games.

**ADAN BARRIENTOS**                      **BROCKPORT**

**6-3 285 OT/OG**

2017: 1st Team Empire 8. Part of an O-line that put up four games of over 500 yards of offense, leading the conference and ranking 28th nationally in total offense.

---

**SETH BRITTON**                              **BUFFALO STATE**

**6-5 325 OT/**

Big-bodied starting tackle for a balanced offensive team. Good run blocker and pass protector.

---

**ANTHONY CAMPANILE**                      **JOHN HOPKINS**

**6-5 285 OT/**

2017: Was a repeat second team All-Centennial selection in his second season as a starter. Campanile, who plays right tackle, was the Blue Jays' most experienced offensive lineman with 40 career games played. He is the leader of an offensive line that has paved the way for a unit that is averaging 40.6 points and 513.7 yards per game.

**CORBIN CAMPITELLI**                      **MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR**

**6-5 295 OT/OG**

Three-year starter. 2017: ASC All-Conference First Team. Helped clear the way for a UMHB offense that averaged 177 rushing yards and 399 yards of total offense on the season. 2016: All-ASC Honorable Mention selection.

---

**STERLING CLARK**                      **WILMINGTON**

**6-6 325 OT/**

2017: Earned All-OAC honorable mention for his position as an offensive lineman. Starting in ten games, Clark was a part of an offensive line that totaled 1502- rushing yards throughout the duration of the season. Made vast improvements over career.

---

**BRANDON DARIAS**                      **HUSSON**

**6-7 305 OT/**

Helped anchor an offensive line that led the ECFC with 2732 rushing yards (273.2 per game) and scored a league-high 39 touchdowns on the ground. Husson also topped 1,500 passing yards (1,740) for the third straight season, led the conference with 41.3 points per game and 4,472 yards of total offense (447.2).

**KHARI DEMOS**                      **ST. JOHN FISHER**

**6-4 305 OT/**

2017: Was placed on the First-Team after anchoring an offensive line that produced over 142 rushing yards per game this season. Demos, who was named a captain in 2017 and was a Second-Team All-Conference selection in 2016, started all 10 games at right tackle and was often responsible for shutting down the opposition's top pass rushers.

**TYLER ECKLER**                      **CARNEGIE MELLON**

**6-4 295 OT/OG**

A first team All-PAC and All-UAA member, played a key part in blocking for one of the nation's top rushers the past three seasons. He appeared in 32 contests during that span and started every game the past two seasons. Eckler fronted an offensive line that helped the Tartans reach the 510-yard mark in the Tartans' win over the University of Rochester while compiling 496 yards against nationally ranked Case Western Reserve University.

**MATT FITCHET**                      **MOUNT UNION**

**6-4 290 OT/**

2017: CoSIDA Academic All-America second team, CoSIDA Academic All-District, Academic All-OAC, All-OAC first team, Started all 15 games at right tackle on offensive line.

**MATT GONO****WESLEY COLLEGE****6-4 310 OT/OG**

Semifinalist for the 2017 Gagliardi Trophy. Has started every game since his freshman season. 2015 D3football.com All-American. Two-time D3football All-East Region first-team member, and a three-time All-NJCA selection. Wolverines average more than 400 yards of offense a game. Wesley led the NJAC in total offense and points scored going into the NCAA Division III playoffs.

**DARRYL GUILFORD****ROWAN****6-7 330 OT/**

2017: Started all 10 games at right tackle. Rowan ranked sixth in the New Jersey Athletic Conference (NJAC) in rushing (100.2 ypg) and sacks against (26) and seventh in passing (107.2 ypg). Received NJAC All-Conference honorable mention. A team captain. Transferred from Wesley College.

**SAMMY HAYES****FRANKLIN COLLEGE****6-4 295 OT/**

2017: Collected First Team All-HAAC honors. Critical member of a Franklin offense that led the league in points scored with 50.1 points per game.

---

**ZACK KENNEDY****CAPITAL****6-3 310 OT/OG**

2017: Collected his second all-conference honor after serving as the Crusaders' left tackle in his third year starting at the position. This marks the second time Kennedy has been named Second Team All-OAC in his career.

---

**JACOB LANGENBERG****COE****6-3 301 OT/OG**

2017: Made the jump to the first team All-IIAC. Led a unit that generated 427.6 yards of

total offense per contest. O-line gave up just 11 sacks in 371 attempts. 2016: honorable mention All-IIAC.

**ST. THOMAS**

**6-6 306 OT/**

Former TE. Helped the Tommie's balanced offense average more than 47 points a game and score 75 offensive TDs, tied with the Oklahoma Sooners for third most among all 660 NCAA teams.

**TYLER MARTINKUS**

**CONCORDIA(WI)**

**6-9 315 OT/**

Three-year starter. Appeared in and started all 10 games. Helped the Falcons offense average 329.4 total offensive yards per game. CUW finished with 2,061 passing yards and 14 touchdowns, while rushing for 1,233 yards and seven touchdowns.

**SUNY-MARITIME**

**6-4 290 OT/**

**KEVIN MERKLE****MONTCLAIR STATE****6-4 300 OT/OG**

2017: Appeared in 10 games. Named First Team in the NJAC. Now a two-time All-Conference selection as he anchored the offensive line from his right tackle position. Merkle was named Honorable Mention in 2015.

---

**RYAN MERLAU****CASE WESTERN****6-3 285 OT/OG**

2016: Selected to the All-UAA Second Team and an honorable mention to the All-PAC Team. Served as a team co-captain.

---

**AUSTIN MILLER****ROCKFORD****6-6 300 OT/**

2017: Saved his best season for last, earning his first ever First Team All-NACC selection. Miller anchored a Rockford offensive line that produced 1,819 yards rushing in just 9 games, which is the sixth highest single-season total in school history. The line was equally as impressive in pass protection as the Regents allowed a NACC low 9 sacks.

**JORDAN MUELLER****WISCONSIN-WHITEWATER****6-5 310 OT/**

2017: All-WIAC honorable mention. Helped the team finish second in the league in rushing offense (172.3 ypg) and third in red zone offense (73.5 percent). The Warhawks averaged 23.0 points per game.

---

**STEPHEN NOONAN****GEORGE FOX****6-8 300 OT/**

2017: Part of a good and unusually large O-line for a D-III school. 1st year as a starter, has seen steady time since sophomore year.

---

**VINCE PORPORATO****WHITWORTH****6-3 290 OT/**

2017: 2nd Team All-NWC. A three-year starter, the last two at right tackle. Instrumental in the Pirates leading the league in fewest sacks allowed and third down conversion percentage.

---

**DEREK SCHIPPER****WARTBURG****6-6 293 OT/**

2017: 1st Team All-IIAC in his first year as a full-time starter. Team was undefeated and dominated competition. Very balanced offense.

---

**NOLAN SCHULER****GEORGE FOX****6-6 280 OT/**

2017: The first Bruin to garner the honor from the AFCA as a second-team selection. Was named second-team offense on the 2017 D3Football.com All-West Region Team and was selected as a first-team All-NWC member. As for his career, Schuler caps off a spectacular four seasons as a three-time All-NWC selection, a two-time D3Football.com All-West Region Team selection and the first to grab a spot on the AFCA Div. III Coaches' All-America Team. A no stranger to firsts, he was also the first offensive lineman to earn a first-team All-NWC selection and the first to be named twice on the D3Football.com All-West Region Team.

**CHRIS SIMMONS****TRINITY****6-3 300 OT/OG**

2017: Earned AFCA First Team All-American and New England Football Writers Division II/III All-New England honors for the second straight year and All-NESCAC recognition for the fourth consecutive season to cap off his college career. He was the Rookie of the Year in 2014 and earned First Team honors in 2015 and 2016 and was an American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Division III All-American, New England Football Writers Division II/III All-Star and D3Football.com All-East Region honoree last season as a junior. This fall, Simmons was the leader of a Bantam offensive line that helped the offense score a league-high 305 points, average 33.9 points per game, and lead the league in yards per rush (4.6) and passing yards per attempt (8.7). Trinity quarterbacks were sacked just 14 times in nine games this fall.

**CAL SMITH**                      **CENTRAL**

**6-4 290 OT/OG**

2017: All-Iowa Conference, first team. Was the left tackle for the top total offense in the conference, averaging 476.1 yards per contest. As an offensive line unit, the Dutch allowed only six sacks in eight league games. Central was also tied for second with 185 first downs.

**JACOB SOFRONKO**                      **HANOVER**

**6-7 310 OT/**

Helped lead HC to a 25-yard improvement in rushing yards per game, as the Panthers averaged 129.0 yards on the ground. The team also rushed for over 150 yards on three occasions, with two of the strong performances going over 200 yards.

**WESLEY SPENCER**                      **HAMPDEN-SYDNEY**

**6-5 295 OT/**

2017: 1st Team All-ODAC. Helped anchor the Tigers' offensive line that helped the team average 400 yards-per-game, including 79.2 on the ground, to go with 29.3 points-per-game.

---

**JAKE TOWNSEND**                      **FROSTBURG STATE**

**6-5 280 OT/**

2017: A mainstay at left tackle for Frostburg starting 41 career games and starting all 13 games this fall. A three-time All-NJAC selection, Townsend helped Frostburg rank 10th in the nation in first downs (276) and second in the NJAC in total offense (418.4).

**ISAIAH TRUSSELL**                      **CARTHAGE**

**6-3 320 OT/OG**

Received first team honors for the second straight season and third all-conference honors in his career, adding to the second team award in 2015. Trussell was a rock on the offensive line that battled injury much of the season, starting all 10 games at left tackle.
