

**ALEC BERGMANN Martin Luther 6-7 320 OT**

All-UMAC. Bergmann started for most of his four-year career, and helped pave the way for some of the most prolific running games in program history. This season, Bergmann helped the Knights average 190.4 rushing yards per game, second-best in the UMAC. Bergmann also served as one of three captains on this year's team

**WILLIE BRITT Muhlenberg 6-4 280 OT OG**

Named to the All-CC first team three straight years. He has started all 43 Muhlenberg games in his career, and this year he helped pave the way for a potent offense that averaged more than 41 points and 477 yards per game.

**BRANDON BROWN Albion 6-8 340 OT OG**

All-Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association football 2nd team, paved the way for the offense to average 381 yards per game

**AUSTIN COLEMAN St. John Fisher 6-4 305 OT OG**

All-Conference First Team. Anchored an offensive line that helped the Cardinals average 114.8 rushing yards per game. The line opened up wide holes all season, allowing for Fisher to score 19 touchdowns on the ground. With Coleman blocking on the left side the line combined to only allow 36 sacks through 11 games.

**CASEY COOK Kenyon 6-4 280 OT OG**

Played a big role in the Lords' offensive success. From his left tackle spot, he created time and space for Merkle and the passing attack. A first-timer on the All-NCAC team, Cook made way for Kenyon backs to run for 728 yards and 10 touchdowns. He played in all 30 games over the last three seasons and 32 in his collegiate career.

**KHARI DEMOS St. John Fisher 6-4 305 OT OG**

All-Conference 2nd Team. Anchored an offensive line that helped the Cardinals average 114.8 rushing yards per game. The line opened up wide holes all season, allowing for Fisher to score 19 touchdowns on the ground. With Demos on the right, the line combined to only allow 36 sacks through 11 games. Attended the University at Buffalo for one season and played football.

**MICHAEL FISHER St. Lawrence 6-3 322 OT OG**

Key member of the offensive line, helped lead the team to school records for passing yards and total offense.

**CONNOLLY FULLER Mary Hardin-Baylor 6-7 315 OT**

Recovering from a knee injury to once again help anchor the offensive line from his tackle position. 1st Team ASC IN '16, Honorable Mention All-ASC selection in '14.

**WILL HILBERT St. Thomas 6-6 301 OT OG**

On the Tommie offensive line, Hilbert started all 49 games on his career at offensive tackle and helped UST post a 42-7 record with an NCAA runner-up finish and two MIAC crowns. The 2016 Mike Stam winner (conference Lineman of the Year, OL-DL), Hilbert was a 2015 honorable mention All-America helping produce 51.2 ppg and 516 ypg in last season's 14-1 finish. In the last two seasons he's blocked for 100-yard rushing performances on 19 occasions and 15 days of 250-plus yards by the Tommie quarterbacks, while helping UST to a 26-2 record. In the last four years the Tommie offense has had eight different athletes rush for 100 or more yards at least once -- in all 30 total 100-yard rushing performances. The same four-year span has produced 36 games with 200 or more passing yards.

**TYLER HOWLETT Texas Lutheran 6-3 300 OT OG**

Anchored the left side of the Bulldog offensive line. Howlett started all 10 games at left tackle. Howlett earned his second consecutive All-SCAC First Team honor.

**DUSTIN IHNS Simpson 6-4 300 OT OG**

Earned second team all-conference honors for the second year in a row. A staple on the Storm's offensive line, Ihns started 19 games at left tackle over the last two seasons after moving from the defensive line. With Ihns protecting the blind side, Simpson allowed just 24 sacks over the past two seasons, the second-fewest in the conference during the stretch.

**BROOKS JENKINS Mount Union 6-4 285 OT OG**

Started two Stagg Bowls (14, 15) at left tackle. Started 34 games over career. 2016: AFCA All-America First Team, D3football.com All-North Region First Team, OAC Ken Wable Award (top offensive lineman), All-OAC First Team, Started all 14 games at left tackle.

**BRETT JERDEE UW-Platteville 6-5 280 OT OG**

Jerdee earned his second straight first-team selection, anchoring the offensive line that has helped the Pioneers average a conference-best 496.7 yards and a league-best 42.0 points per game.

**BRYN KAUFMAN Westminster (Pa.) 6-4 295 OT**

2016: Secured ECAC South All-Stars Second Team honor. Kaufman anchored the Titan offensive line. He received Honorable Mention recognition last year.

**TONY KOEPNICK UW-Whitewater 6-3 322 OT OG**

A second team All-American, started nine games at offensive tackle for UW-Whitewater. He was named first team all-conference and first team D3football.com All-West Region after helping the Warhawks average nearly 35 points and 200 rushing yards per game.

**MARK KOZHAYA Whittier College 6-4 330 OT**

Kozhaya was a 2nd Team All-SCIAC performer for the second year in a row. He has been a four-year starter for the Purple & Gold anchoring an offensive line that helped the Purple & Gold average 292.7 yards per game, which included 118.4 rushing and 174.2 passing.

**KYLE MARTELL Juniata 6-4 350 OT**

2nd team all-conference, has been a stalwart on the offensive line for Juniata. He has started all 20 games for JC during his time. Helped Juniata average nearly 142 rushing yards per game which is the most in three years.

**T.J. MUZZONIGRO Tufts 6-3 290 OT OG**

Muzzonigro stepped into a starting role at right tackle following an injury to opening-day starter Josh Thibeault and played every snap the rest of the way. A tough run blocker and intelligent player, he was at the heart of a Jumbo offense that topped 40 points three times and averaged 37.2 points per game over the last six weeks of the season. All-Conference second team.

**ROBERT PONTBRIAND Utica College 6-5 295 OT**

Pontbriand made his second straight appearance on an all-conference team for Utica after earning honorable mention in 2015. He helped Utica running back set a new school-record this past season for both single season (995) and career (1,876) rushing yards. He also protected senior quarterback who will graduate ranked second on the College's all-time list in career passing yards (5465), completions (447) and TD passes (30). Pontbriand and the UC offense recorded 4,168 yards of total offense this year, which ranks second on the College's all-time single-season list.

**ADAM PRINCE UW-Stevens Point 6-7 311 OT**

Added an All-WIAC award to his CoSIDA Academic All-District honor. He started all 10 games and helped the Pointers offense generate 2,885 yards through the air this season.

**NICK REESE Pacific 6-6 285 OT OG**

1st Teamer who earned second team all-NWC honors in 2015, was a mainstay on an offensive line unit that averaged 266.7 yards passing and 168.4 yards on the ground.

**JAYSON ROTHMEIER Crown 6-3 350 OT OG**

Made the UMAC second team All-Conference roster for the second year in a row, as he was a solid foundation for the great senior seasons for the running backs.. He started every single game for the team this season.

**LOGAN SHIPPERT Illinois College 6-5 300 OT**

Helped Illinois College rack up 30.0 points per game on the season while gaining more than 4,000 yards of total offense.
