

Marty & Matt's Small College Scouting Report



JORDAN DASCALO

EASTERN WASHINGTON

6-1 220 P/PK

Transfer from Washington State, 2017: NFLPA Collegiate Bowl, 1st All Big Sky, Stats-42.6 AVG. Dascalo was the only Eagle to earn first team All-Big Sky Conference honors this past season. Played for the Cougars in 2014 before playing his final three seasons for EWU. He led the Big Sky and was 16th in the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision in average per punt (42.6) in the 2017 season, with 16 of his 47 punts downed inside the opponent 20-yard line. His outstanding control and hang time helped Eastern rank 17th in FCS in net punting (38.24), allowing just 3.50 yards by opponents on punt returns in 2017 to rank fifth nationally. He had 12 punts of at least 50 yards in 2017, including a career-long 67-yarder that helped him earn National Player of the Week and Big Sky Conference Player of the Week honors following EWU's win at North Dakota on Nov. 11. His average in 2017 was the seventh-best performance in school history, and he concluded his Eastern career with 125 punts for a 41.4 career average to rank third in school history. In his career, Dascalo had 39 punts downed inside the 20. He had 13 punts in his career of at least 56 yards, including a pair of career-long 67-yard kicks to rank sixth in school history. He was also 4-of-7 in his EWU career kicking field goals, and averaged 59.9 yards (7,303 total yards) in 122 career kickoffs with 47 touchbacks. 2016: Stats-40.7 AVG.

2017: 1st All CAA, Stats-58 att, 42.9 AVG. One of the top punters in the nation this season, and he ended the year leading CAA Football and ranked 10th nationally with an average of 42.9 yards per punt. 2016: 3rd All CAA.

JON CROFT HOLLINSWORTH**FURMAN****5-11 170 P/PK**

2017: 42.1 AVG, 71 lng, 62.6 y/KO. Served as Furman's punter while also handling kickoff duties for a third consecutive season. 2016: STATS-40.2 AVG Punt, 7 FGs, 46 lng.

OWEN HOOLIHAN**PRARIE VIEW A&M****6-0 170 P/PK**

Averaged 40.2 y/p in '15 and scored 63 pts kicking. 2016: 2nd All SWAC, 2017: Stats-46 att, 38.7 AVG

MAX PEDINOFF**NEW HAMPSHIRE****6-0 235 P/PK**

2017: Stats-69 Punt atts, 39.5 AVG, 4/8 FGs, 41 lng. Dream Bowl. Received the team's Bob Demers 12th Man Award. Pedinoff was UNH's primary punter and also split time as the kicker for field goals and PATs. He averaged 39.5 yards per punt on 69 boots with 30 fair catches, 21 inside the 20 and four punts of 50-plus yards. Offensively, he made 4 of 8 field goal attempts and was 15-for-16 on PAT kicks for a total of 27 points.

AUSTIN BARNARD**SAMFORD****6-4 210 P/**

Miami transfer. 2017: 2nd All SoCon, 3rd AP All American, 3rd Madness All American, 3rd Phil Steele All American, Stats-45.2 AVG, 60 lng, 62.7 y/KO. Led the Southern Conference and ranked second in the nation, averaging a school-record 45.2 yards on 54 punts. He had 18 punts of 50 yards or more, and 18 that were placed inside the 20-yard line. Also handled

kickoff duties for Samford, averaging 62.7 yards on 67 kickoffs. 2016: STATS-64 att, 41.7 AVG, 64 lng.

THOMAS BOULDIN INDIANA STATE

6-2 210 P/

2017: HM All MVC, Had 72 punts on the season for 3,050 total yards. Averaged 42.4 yards per punt. Had 16 punts of 50 or more yards. Has pinned opponents inside the 20-yard line, 23 times. Booted an ISU and MVFC 90-yard punt against Southern Illinois. Had two pass competitions for 47 yards. Stats-72 att, 42.4 AVG, 90 lng. 2016: STATS-60 att, 41.0 AVG, 70 lng.

CODY EDWARDS EASTERN ILLINOIS

6-3 220 P/

2017: Stats-75 att, 38.9 AVG, 74 lng. Punted in all 11 games and served as the field goal holder in all 11 games. averaged 38.9 yards per punt with 14 punts inside the 20-yard line and 15 punts resulting in fair catches. had seven punts over 50 yards with a long of 74 yards against Illinois State which ranks as the sixth longest punt in EIU's NCAA Division I history.

CHRISTIAN GUZMAN HOUSTON BAPTIST

5-11 185 P/

2017: Picked up his third all-conference honor and second second-team selection. The Brookshire, Texas, native ranked second in the league and 18th nationally with a 42.5-yard average and ranked eighth nationally in net punting average. Guzman finish his career with the third-best average in conference history at 42.8 yards per punt and the most punting yards in Southland history with 11,695.2nd All Southland, Stats-76 att, 42.5 AVG, 61 lng. 2016: HM All Southland, STATS-80 att, 41.6 AVG.

HUNTER KELLEY PENN

6-1 185 P/

2017: HM All Ivy, Stats-40.5 AVG. A second straight All-Ivy selection came Kelley's way after he ranked No. 2 among Ivy punters in average (40.5). Called upon just 39 times – the

fewest among Ivy punters – Kelley dropped 13 of his 39 punts inside the 20 and only had two go for touchbacks. 2016: HM All Ivy, STATS-42.7 AVG, 63 lng.

JACKSON KOONCE **NORTH DAKOTA STATE**

6-1 197 P/

SMU transfer, 2016: MVC All Newcomer, 60 att, 37.6 AVG. 2017: 39.4 AVG. Played the 2014 and 2015 seasons for Southern Methodist University. Averaged 40.5 yards on 101 punts over two seasons with a long of 60 yards. Finished the 2014 season third in SMU history for punting yards (3,017) and fourth in punt attempts (74). Appeared in only four games his sophomore year, punting 27 times for an average of 39.6 yards.

2017: 2nd All ECAC, 1st All Ivy, Stats-50 atts, 42.9 AVG, 66 lng. For the third year in a row, a Columbia punter has earned All-Ivy League honors as Thome earns First Team All-

Ivy League accolades. Thome led the Ivy League and ranks No. 11 nationally in punting with a 42.9 yards per punt average. In 50 punts, Thome had 10 punts travel 50 yards or more, placed 23 inside the 20-yard line and 12 end in a fair catch. His long was a 66-yard punt.

NATHANIEL TILQUE

NC CENTRAL

6-2 190 P/

Broke the NCCU record with 10,007 career punting yards. Ranks third in school history with a 39.6-yard career punting average. In four standout seasons, regularly pinned opponents deep in their own territory, placing 83 punts inside the 20-yard line with only 19 touchbacks. 2017: Voted All-MEAC First Team. Earned BOXTOROW All-America Honorable Mention recognition. Averaged 39.9 yards per punt, while placing 26 of his 68 punts inside the 20-yard line (38.2%) with only six touchbacks. Completed his only career pass attempt for a 27-yard first down conversion at Hampton (Nov. 4). Promoted to Team Captain midway through the season in recognition of his leadership.

TREY TURNER

LIBERTY

5-11 210 P/

2017: 2nd All Big South, Stats-40.7 AVG. Finished his career as Liberty's all-time leader in punting average (40.7 yards per punt) and became Liberty's first four-time all-conference selection since linebacker Nick Sigmon (2011-14). 2016: 1st All Big South, Stats-63 att, 41.0 AVG.

TREVOR VINCENT

ALABAMA STATE

6-2 195 P/

LSU transfer, 2017: 2nd All SWAC, Stats-63 att, 40.5 AVG, 75 lng. Fourth in the conference in punting at 40.5 yards per punt, having punted the ball 63 times on the year. He recorded eight punts of 50-plus yards, which include four punts over 60 yards and a career long of 75 yards against Grambling State, while the senior had one touchback and forced 14 fair catches on the season. He punted the ball 25 times inside the 20 for the Hornets, while allowing just 15 punts returns this season, just over one per game for just 4.43 yards per return.

2017: 3rd All Big Sky, Stats-60 att, 42.2 AVG, 67 lng, 30 i/20. Earned all-conference honors for the second-straight season as he was named to the third team. DeMaio was sixth in the Big Sky in punting yards per punt. 2016: 2nd All Big Sky, Stats-43.5 AVG, 91 lng.

2017: 2nd All Patriot, Stats-14/20 FGs, 46 lng. Matched Bucknell's record by booting 14 field goals, including a game winner as time expired against Sacred Heart.

2017: HM All Southland. Earned the starting placekicker spot prior to the season. The Dodge City, Kansas native was 9-for-13 on field goals with all of his misses coming from beyond 42 yards. His 77.8 field goal percentage and 14 field goal makes were tied for most in the MVFC and he was also perfect 34-for-34 in point after touchdown attempts. 2016: HM All MVC, STATS-16 FGs, 84 pts, 50 lng.
