2017: 4 rec, 99 yds, TD. Has game experience, primarily as a blocker, but does have good ability and potential as a receiving tight end. Has great size for the position. Experienced Long Snapper and blocker at TE.

3yr starter at Long Snapper, 2017: FCS Bowl, Spiral Tropical Bowl. Played in 50 games during his EIU career as the Panthers long snapper. The 50 games rank as the fourth most played by an EIU player in school history. The senior was part of the Panthers OVC Championship team as a true freshman in 2013 until he was injured during the fourth game of the season at Northern Illinois. He would return to serve as the long snapper for the next four seasons, EIU posting winning seasons in each of his final three years with an FCS playoff appearance in 2015.

2017: All Academic, CoSIDA Academic All American, 1st All Big South (LS), CoSIDA All District 3, 2nd STATS All American (LS), 2nd HERO All American (LS). Was garnered inclusion on the all-state team after earning STATS FCS and Hero Sports second-team All-America honors. The All-Big South first-team honoree started 47 career games at Liberty. The redshirt senior did not record a bad snap during his last three seasons. 2016: 3rd STATS All American (LS), 1st All Big South.

2017: A consensus first team All-Southern Conference selection this past fall, caught 32

passes for 652 yards and team leading nine touchdowns in helping Furman to an 8-5 record and second round appearance in the FCS playoffs. Ranked among the FCS leaders in yards per catch (20.4). NICHOLAS BOKUN PENN

2017: 2nd All Ivy, Stats-20 rec, 289 yds, 14.4 AVG, 2 TDs. It was a career year for Bokun as he set personal single-season bests in receptions (20), yards (289) and touchdowns (2) – eclipsing his totals for his previous three years in all three categories.

ANDREW CASKIN WILLIAM & MARY

2017: College Gridiron Showcase, 3rd All CAA, A three-time All-Colonial Athletic Association selection, Caskin established himself as one of the nation's top tight ends during the past few seasons. In addition to logging 37 career starts, his impressive career totals include 86 catches for 868 yards and seven touchdowns. Also an outstanding student and leader, Caskin, a team captain, was chosen as a 2017 National Football Foundation Campbell Trophy Semifinalist. JAMES COLEMAN AUSTIN PEAY

2017: Stats-9rcp, 93 yds. Dream Bowl. 2016: STATS-13 rec, 115 yds, 4 Yds.

CONNOR DAVIS STONY BROOK

6-8 260 TE/

Has played TE, DE and OT, in 2015, he started all 10 games as the right tackle on the offensive line. In 2016, he had a start on the D-line. 2017: 5 rec, 38 yds

CHANDLER DEXTER**CENTRAL ARKANSAS****6-6 260 TE/**

2017: Helped block for a UCA offense that rushed for 207.8 yards per game and passed for 260.4. UCA's offensive line has allowed only six sacks through 11 games, which ranks second in the country. Stats-6 rec, 69 yds, 11.5 avg. All Conference JC transfer.

JOBY EMBREY**MOREHEAD STATE****6-4 245 TE/**

2017: FCS Bowl. Played in first six games of the year and the season finale, giving him seven total games played. Caught two passes for three yards. Career included 41 games with 19 starts. Caught 27 passes for 276 yards with three career touchdowns. 2016: STATS-15 rec, 140 yds, 2 TDs.

DALLAS GOEDERT**SOUTH DAKOTA STATE****6-5 260 TE/**

2017: Senior Bowl, Athlon All American, 1st AP FCS All American, 1st All MVC, ADA All American, 1st STATS All American, 1st Madness All American, 1st HERO All American, 1st Phil Steele All American, 1st AFCA All American, Walter Camp FCS All American. During the recently completed 2017 season, Goedert finished as the team leader with 72 receptions and 1,111 receiving yards, while adding seven touchdown catches. His receiving total leads all Division I tight ends – FCS and FBS – this season. For his career, Goedert ranked third in receptions at SDSU with 198, fourth in receiving yards with 2,988 and sixth with 21 touchdown receptions. Goedert has been a unanimous All-America selection each of the past two seasons Stats-72 rec, 1111 yds, 15.4 AVG, 7 TDs, 79.4 y/g. 2016: 1st AFCA All American, 1st FCS AP All American, Walter Camp All American, 1st STATS All American, ADA All American, 1st All MVC, STATS-92 rec, 1293 yds, 11 TDs, 14.1 AVG, 99.5 y/g.

2017: HM All Ivy, Stats-8 rec, 118 yds, 14.8 AVG, TD. A terrific blocker.

2017: HBCU Bowl. Finished with 10 rec, 86 yds, 8.60 avg, TD.

ANDREW PODBIELSKI **BUCKNELL**

6-4 240 TE/

2017: Stats-22 rec, 240 yds, TD. He enjoyed his most productive offensive campaign as a senior, posting a career-high 240 receiving yards despite missing two games due to injury. One of only four Bison seniors who started at least 30 games, he wrapped up his career with 537 receiving yards and two touchdowns. 2016: CoSida All District 2, STATS-20 rec, TD.

KEVIN RADER **YOUNGSTOWN STATE**

6-5 250 TE/

2017: HM All MVC, Had receptions in 10 of 11 games. At Pittsburgh caught six passes for 100 yards. Had 19 career catches entering the 2017 season. Stats-22 rec, 272 yds, 12.4 AVG, 2 TDs. 2016: STATS-17 rec, 285 yds, 2 TDs.

STONE SANDER **SACRAMENTO STATE**

6-4 240 TE/

2017: Appeared in six games, starting each at tight end. Opened the year as the starter in the first five games before injuring his ankle at Eastern Washington. Returned for the final game of the season against UC Davis. Had four receptions for 98 yards during the year; the bulk of those numbers came in the win over Southern Utah where he had three catches for 78 yards, including a 40-yard reception. Earned Big Sky all-academic honors.

CALEB SCEPANIAK **WAGNER**

6-6 260 TE/

2017: Stats-5 rec, 64 yds, TD. Has good size and athleticism. Needed more targets.

JAKE SUTHERLAND**MOREHEAD STATE****6-5 265 TE/**

2017: FCS Bowl, Stats-31 rec, 249 yds, 2 TDs. Hauled in 31 catches for 249 yards and two touchdowns this past season, starting all 11 games. Sutherland also played a key role on special teams, making five tackles on kick coverage. He had more than 30 career tackles as a special teams player as well. 2016: STATS-14 rec, 196 yds, 14.0 AVG, 3 TDs.

MATT VALENZUELA**ST. FRANCIS (PA)****6-4 245 TE/**

2017: CoSIDA All District 2, Team Captain. Appeared in 10 games, starting eight, this season. Tallied 15 catches for 108 yards and a touchdown.

ANDREW VOLLERT**WEBER STATE****6-5 245 TE/**

San Jose State transfer, 2017: East-West Shrine, 2nd Madness All American, 1st All Big Sky, ADA Academic All Star, 3rd HERO All American, 2nd AFCA All American, 2nd AP All American, 2nd STATS All American, 2nd Phil Steele All American, CoSIDA All District 8, a consensus All-American in 2017, helping Weber State to the Big Sky Championship, a school-record 11 wins, a top-five national ranking and two FCS Playoff wins. Vollert served as a team captain and played in all 14 games for Weber State this past season. He became the 12th player in Weber State history to earn All-America honors twice in a career. Led the Wildcats in receptions and receiving yards for the second-straight season, finishing with 61 receptions for 773 yards and five touchdowns. He finished his two-year ranking 17th in Weber State history in receiving yards with 1,613 and 19th in career receptions with 123. Vollert was a unanimous selection to the Big Sky All-Conference first team. Stats-61 rec, 773 yds, 12.7 AVG, 5 TDs, pass-2 TDs. 2016: 3rd FCS AP All American, 3rd STATS All American, 1st All Big Sky (Newcomer of the Year), Stats-62 rec, 840 yds, 7 TDs, 13.5 AVG.

DYLAN WADSWORTH**LAFAYETTE****6-3 245 TE/**

2017: 1st All Patriot, Team captain and a Preseason All-Patriot League selection, finished second on the team with 41 receptions for 293 yards and one touchdown.
