

ERIK ANDERSON

OLIVET NAZARENE

6-1 213 RB/

2017: Named MSFA Midwest All-League First Team Offense. This is the first such selection of his career, he was named honorable mention a year ago. Anderson set career-highs and led the Tigers with 200 carries for 986 yards (89.6). Anderson also rushed for a career-high 10 rushing touchdowns and caught one other. He finished with 18 receptions for 129 yards and also threw for one touchdown. Anderson finished sixth in the MSFA in rushing yards per game.

TYRONE CAMPBELL

MCPHERSON

5-11 205 RB/

2017: Honorable Mention All-KCAC. Finished as the team's leading rusher with 469 yards and five touchdowns on 108 carries, while also hauling in 12 passes for 147 yards and two scores. He had two 100-yard games this season. 2016: 2nd Team All-KCAC.

JUSTIN CARROLL ARIZONA CHRISTIAN 6-0 230 RB/FB

2017: Honorable Mention All-CSFL. Team's leading rusher who seldom gets caught behind the line. Good receiver as well. Had 83 carries for 569 yards a 6.9 average and 4 Caught 18 passes for 115 yards for a 6.4 average and a TD. 2016: 2nd Team All-CSFL.

WADE HOLTSCLAW

CAMBELLSVILLE

5-10 200 RB/

2017: All-NCCAA First Team. First Team All Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division. Led the Tigers in rushing this past season racking up 640 yards and leading the team with 14 touchdowns. Holtsclaw also led the team in scoring with 84 points, while he notched a rushing touchdown in all but one game this season.

MIKE IVLOW

ST. XAVIER

5-10 195 RB/

Projected 3rd down back, good hands. 2017: Named All-MSFA Second Team. Carried the rock 162 times for 1092yards, a 6.7 yds/carry average and 7 TDs. Also caught 16 passes for 117 yards, a 7.3 yds/rec average and a TD.

BUBBA JENKINS

MORNINGSIDE

5-10 205 RB/

2017: Victory Sports Network (VSN), AFCA and AP 2017 All-America Football Team. Led the nation in rushing with 2160 yards and an average of 154.3 yards per game. Jenkins rushed for 28 touchdowns and an average of 6.2 yards per carry. Jenkins, who had 18 pass receptions for 178 yards and a touchdown, ranked fifth in the nation with an average of 167.0 all-purpose yards per game and third in scoring with an average of 12.9 points per game. Jenkins rushed for over 100 yards in 12 of the Mustangs' 14 contests, including a season's high 238 yards in a 56-16 win against Hastings College for the seventh highest single-game rushing performance in Morningside history. Transfer from SW Baptist.

EJAY JOHNSON

BENEDICTINE (KS)

5-9 190 RB/

2017: AFCA-NAIA All-America 1st team. Finished the season with 1,397 yards rushing off 244 careers with 19 touchdowns. He also caught 16 passes for 142 yards to finish the season with a total yards per game average of 128.3. He ranked No. 5 in total scoring TDs with 114 points, No. 6 in total scoring and No. 7 in the NAIA in total rushing (1,397). 2016: All-Heart North 1st team

JP LOWERY SAGU

5-10 200 RB/

2017: CSFL All-Conference 1st Team. Hard-running back with decent speed and agility. Seldom loses yardage. Had 125 carries, 858 yards for a 6.9 yds/carry average and 13 TDs. Also caught 5 passes for 50 yards out of the backfield. Shared carries.

DEMONTE MCCLARY AVILA

5-10 220 RB/

2017: Picked up second team all-conference honors for the second consecutive season, leading Avila in rushing despite missing four games. McClary finished his senior campaign with 447 rushing yards on 84 carries, good for an average of 5.2 YPC. McClary also found the end zone four times this season. McClary closed out his career with 277 carries over three seasons, rushing for 1,450 yards and 11 touchdowns on the ground and 1 more through the air. His career average of 5.2 YPC ranks him in the top five in program history in that category.

JARRELL REYNOLDS

SOUTHEASTERN

5-9 185 RB/

2017: For the third time in his career, running back Jarrell Reynolds was selected as the Mid-South Conference Player of the Year, leading the entire conference in rushing per game at 103.1, and has 20 touchdowns. Also had his fourth 1,000-yard rushing season.

HUNTER THOMSEN

MONTANA WESTERN

5-10 200 RB/

2017: All-Frontier Second Team. Led the team in rushing with 975 yards on 230 carries, and 5 touchdowns, he also had 214 yards receiving with 2 scores. He was 27th in the nation in total rushing.

Walser led the team in receiving with 811 yards, and scored 5 touchdowns. He was ranked 27th in the nation in total receiving yards.

MICAH BROWN 6-0 235 FB/ **MARION**

2017: Made nine appearances as a fullback, blocked for a team that ranked fourth in the nation in rushing yards per game (283.2) and number eight in total rushing offense (2832 yards). Allowed only nine sacks, which ranked fourth in the country. Had three carries for eight yards a touchdown Nov. 4 vs. Missouri Baptist.

TYLER MODLIN

WEBBER INTERNATIONAL

6-0 230 FB/

2017: Helped power the Warrior offense to over 7,500 rushing yards in his career, and he averaged 4.6 yards per carry in his career.

Modlin also finished his four-year career as a Warrior with 100 all-purpose yards, including 82 career rushing yards on 18 carries and five career receptions for 25 yards and two receiving touchdowns. As a senior in 2017, he rushed 10 times for 28 yards and hauled in two catches for nine yards with one receiving touchdown. Additionally, Modlin recorded 15 career tackles while playing on special teams. Named to 2018 Dream Bowl.
