TERRENCE BAILEY

WEBBER INTERNATIONAL

6-2 218 SS/

2017: Named the American Team Defensive MVP of the Fourth Annual 2017 FCS Bowl. Finished his 2017 campaign with 12 total tackles, one sack and two blocked kicks. His career stats include 155 total tackles, 13.5 tackles for loss, three sacks, 12 pass breakups and five interceptions. His best game as a senior came at Southeastern University (Oct. 21) when he finished with eight tackles and 1.5 tackles for loss.

2017: 1st Team All-MSFA MEL. 3-Time 1st Team selection. Had 58 tackles, 6.5 TFLs, 2.0 sacks, 2 INTs (100 YD TD), 3 PBUs, 3 QBHs, FF. 2016 & 2017 NAIA National Champion.

SETH CUNNINGHAM

OLIVET NAZARENE

6-0 193 SS/CB

2017: Selected All-MSFA Midwest Second Team Defense in his first year with the Tigers. He was one of four defensive backs named to the list. He started 10 games for the Tigers and finished with 29 tackles (20 solo, 9 assists). He had 1.5 tackles for loss for seven yards, one interception, five passes broken up and a quarterback hurry.

NATE DESEMONE**MISSOURI VALLEY****5-11 197 SS/**

2017: Heart of America Athletic Conference All-Southern Division 1st Team. A second team selection last season, finished with 30 total tackles, and one interception.

DERECK DEVRIES**DAKOTA STATE****6-2 205 SS/FS**

2017: 1st Team All-NSAA. Led Dakota State with three interceptions (ranks 47th in the NAIA for most interceptions) and returned it for a total of 68 yards in 2017. He had four pass deflections. He also tallied 64 tackles (34 solo, 30 assist). DeVries had a fumble return for 26 yards and a forced fumble twice. DeVries finished his impressive 4-year career at Dakota State with 171 tackles (84 solo, 87 assist), 8 interceptions for total return of 113 yards and 8 pass break-ups.

OSHAY DUNMORE**SOUTHERN OREGON****6-3 215 SS/**

Transfer from Illinois State. 2017: 1st Team All-Frontier. Recorded 52 tackles and four interceptions in his first season at safety. He paired to form the most dominant safety corps in the conference.

ROBERT HARDING, III**ARIZONA CHRISTIAN****6-4 207 SS/FS**

Transfer from Missouri Southern. 2017: Honorable Mention All-CSFL. Plays with passion and mental toughness. Had 27 tackles, 2 TFLs, 2 INTs, FR.

TUCKER JOHNSON**CARROLL COLLEGE****6-1 200 SS/FS**

2017: Earned AFCA All-America Second-Team honors. Was second on the team with 70 tackles and also notched a pair of fumble recoveries which he returned for 50 total yards. A lot of time secondary players are recognized for their interceptions, but he was recognized for his style of play, for the way he led the defense and the tackling he did from the secondary.

MATT KELLY CULVER-STOCKTON

6-3 200 SS/

2017: HM All-Heart North. Played in all 11 games for the Wildcats and was second on the team with 81 total tackles. He totaled a team-high 50 solo tackles, 31 assisted tackles and five tackles for loss. Kelly ranked 10th in the Heart and fourth in the Northern Division with 7.4 tackles per game. In addition, Kelly forced two fumbles, recovered three fumbles and had one interception, which he returned 40 yards for a touchdown.

2017: Second Team All-GPAC. Had 51.5 tackles, 6.5 TFLs, a sack, 2 INTs, 2 PBU, 2 FF and 2 recoveries. 2016: All-GPAC Honorable Mention

MICHAEL NEALY WAYLAND BAPTIST

6-0 185 SS/

played weakside linebacker where over nine games he racked up 102 tackles – more than twice as many as any of his teammates – with 59 solo stops and 43 assists. His 11.3 tackles per game leads the NAIA, and he ranks seventh in fumbles forced per game (three total for 0.3 per game).

DEANTHONY PATRICK CUMBERLAND

6-2 222 SS/

2017: First Team All-Mid-South Conference Bluegrass Division. Led the Phoenix defense with 75 tackles, including 4.5 tackles for loss with two sacks from his safety position. Posted 12 pass breakups (tied for second in the conference), three forced fumbles, two fumble recoveries and one interception.

MICHAEL SMITH LANGSTON

6-3 220 SS/

2017: All-CSFL first team. Was second on the team in total tackles with 56 while finishing

with 42 solo tackles, three interceptions and six tackles for loss; he finishes his Langston career with 73 total tackles, one sack, six tackles for loss and three interceptions.

2017: 2nd Team All-Frontier. Ranks third on the team with 83 tackles and snagged three interceptions. 2016: 2016: Transitioned from running back to strong safety during spring practice, took over a starting job by the fourth week of the season, and ultimately earned All-Frontier Conference second-team recognition.

2015, 2016, 2017 MSFA All-Midwest League First Team. This is the third year in a row that Woodard has taken home academic all-district and first-team all-league honors. The senior tied for second on the squad with eight pass breakups and ranked third on the team in total tackles with 50. Woodard also scored two of the Saints' five defensive touchdowns, a 92-yard fumble return and a 42-yard interception return, this season. He added another fumble recovery, a forced fumble, 3.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks.
