SOUTHEASTERN

6-5 230 TE/

2017: Had 10 rec, 89 yds, 4 TDs. 2016: 1st Team All-Sun Conference

MALIK DUMETZ

6-3 230 TE/WR

2017: Honorable Mention All-GPAC. Had just 18 receptions for 316 yards but 6 of them were for TDs. 2016: All-GPAC Honorable Mention (TE).

SETH FITZKE

CONCORDIA (NEB)

6-4 235 TE/

Bounced back in 2017 after missing the 2016 campaign due to an ACL tear. Though not frequently featured in the passing game (four catches, 37 yards), Fitzke served as an extension of the offensive line as a dominant blocker. A three-time All-GPAC award winner having also been named to the conference's first team in 2015 and to the second team in 2014 & 2017. In his collegiate career, Fitzke caught 35 passes for 300 yards and four touchdowns.

DOMONICK FOY

LANGSTON

6-3 255 TE/

2017: Named Honorable Mention despite not seeing action in 4 games. Only 3 receptions for 45 yards and 15.0 yds/rec. Good size and solid blocking.

JAKE GRAU **GRAND VIEW**

6-4 225 TE/

2017: 1st-Team All-Heart. Strong blocker who had 25 receptions for 280 yards, an 11.2 average and 3 TDs.

PATRICK HALL **BRIAR CLIFF**

6-5 250 TE/

2017: Underutilized tight end. Former D-Lineman. Appeared in nine games for BC...pulled in six receptions for 39 yards...also recorded on tackle (solo). His best game was two receptions for 18 yards against Bethany.

JONATHAN HENDRIX **LYON**

6-3 260 TE/

2017: Participated in the 8th annual D2 vs. NAIA Challenge. Caught 29 passes for 487 yards and two touchdowns during his senior season in 2017. For his career, Hendrix caught 56 passes for 746 yards and five touchdowns. The senior tight end finished his career tied for eighth all-time in school history for total points (30). He was named as a first-team All-CSFL tight end after the 2017 season.

DARRELL HILL, JR. **LANGSTON**

6-6 240 TE/

2017: Named Honorable Mention despite limited playing time and only 2 receptions. Great size and solid blocking.

CODY JOHNSON **UNION (KY)**

6-4 260 TE/

2017: All-Mid-South Conference (MSC) Appalachian Division 2nd Team. Johnson hauled in

22 passes for 271 yards and three touchdowns. The tight end finished his career with 49 receptions for 487 yards.
