

**Tosin Aguebor Mercer 6-3 240 OLB ILB**

2nd All SoCon as a College DE, a four-year captain for the Bears that started all 11 games for Mercer this season. He finished the year with 38 tackles (16 solo, 22 assisted) and was second on the team with 8.5 tackles for a loss of 46 yards including a team-leading 6.0 sacks for a loss of 42 yards. Aguebor forced one fumble and was credited with one quarterback hurry on the year. Stats: 38 TT, 8.5 TFL, 6 Sacks, FF

**Curtis Alexander Florida A&M 6-2 245 OLB**

All-MEAC 3rd Team matured into a leader on the defense. A Preseason First Team pick, who moved from end to tackle, finishing with 42 tackles (25 solos), with 6.0 tackles for loss and 1.5 quarterback sacks.

**Jamal Allen Stephen F. Austin 6-0 250 OLB DE**

Appeared in 44 games during his SFA career with a pair of starts. Finished with 70 total tackles, including 34 solo stops, 19.5 tackles for loss (84 yards) and 12.5 sacks (67 yards). Tallied a forced fumble, two pass deflections and six quarterback hurries. 2016 (Senior): Played in all 11 games with a pair of starts for the Lumberjacks. Registered 22 tackles on the defensive end as SFA ranked among the national leaders in both tackles for loss and sacks. Generated eight solo stops, 7.0 tackles for loss and 5.5 sacks

**Darien Anderson Alcorn State 6-1 240 OLB**

3rd Stats FCS All American, 3rd AP All American, Boxtorow All American. Finished fourth in FCS in sacks with 1.00 per game. He was also top-15 in tackles for loss with 1.6 per outing. Anderson led the SWAC in both categories. Anderson earned All-Conference honors for the second straight year after being named to the 2016 First-Team. **Rashawn Barrett Delaware State 6-2 230 OLB**

Good, steady linebacker. Always provides solid play especially versus the run. Stats: 59 TT, 12.5 TFL, 2 Sacks, PBU, 2 QBH

**Kevin Barry Sacred Heart 6-1 225 OLB**

Earned his first All-NEC honor with his Second Team selection. Barry had 62 tackles on the season, leading SHU with 4.5 sacks while adding 10.0 tackles for loss. He was twice named NEC Defensive Player of the Week in 2016. Barry won that honor on Sept. 5 after having 13 tackles, three tackles for loss, a forced fumble, and a fumble recovery in the season-opening win at Stetson. **Ryan Bennett** *Morehead State* **6-1 215 OLB**

1st All Pioneer, ranked tied for third in the PFL with 102 total tackles and finished his career ranked eighth in program history with 296 total career stops. Bennett had 44 solo tackles and 58 assists this season and also registered 11 tackles for loss. He set the school single-game record with 20 tackles against Jacksonville this season. 2016 Stats: 102 TT, 11 TFL, 1.5 Sacks, INT, 2 QBH

**Kourtney Berry** *Alabama State* **6-0 215 OLB SS**

2nd AFCA All American, Boxtorow All American, 4.5/40, Finished 10th in the conference in tackles per game at 6.6, while also recording 66 total tackles. He also ended up tied for fourth in forced fumbles with three, and added a pair of sacks. Berry finished his career as a three-time All-SWAC performer with his 2016 selection. 2016 Stats: 66 TT, 6 TFL, 2 Sacks, 3 FF

**Austin Calitro** *Villanova* **6-0 250 OLB**

1st All CAA, Stats: 86 TT, 12 TFL, 3.5 Sacks, 4 PBU, 2nd Stats FCS All American, helped anchor a Villanova defense that led all of FCS football in both total defense (259.8 ypg) and scoring defense (15.0 ppg.), and ranked fourth in rushing defense at 87.6 yards per game. In 13 games, Calitro tied for the team lead in total tackles with 86 and he ranked second on the Wildcat team in tackles for loss with 12. He also had four pass break-ups and 3.5 quarterback sacks.

**Dustin Casey** *Morehead State* **6-2 225 OLB**

HM All Pioneer as a DE, tallied 36 total tackles and five stops for losses in 2016. He had three sacks and led the team with six quarterback hurries. 2016 Stats: 36 TT, 5 TFL, 3 Sacks, 3 PBU, 6 QBH

**Taylor Coleman** *Drake* **6-1 220 OLB SS**

2nd All Pioneer, led the team in tackles, recording 68 stops, despite missing the final three games of the season. 2016 Stats: 68 TT, 2 PBU

**Aaron Cook** *Gardner-Webb* **6-1 235 OLB ST**

2nd All Big South, earned All-Big South Conference honors for the third season in a row, despite battling injuries late in the season. Had 63 total tackles (28 solo), five tackles for loss, two interceptions and a pair of blocked kicks. Cook finished his career at the Bandit linebacker post with 255 total hits (131 solo), 30 tackles for loss and nine sacks in four seasons. **Arkez Cooper** *Grambling State* **6-3 225 OLB**

1st All SWAC, hard playing LB with a great motor and intinct. Team's leader in tackleTFLs. Part of a Tigers unit that led the SWAC in most every statistical category and ranked fourth in FCS in points allowed (16.4), as well as ranked first nationally in red zone defense (.577). Stats: 79 TT, 19.5 TFL, 6 Sacks, INT, 3 QBH, FR, 3 FF

**Caleb Counce** *UT-Martin* **6-0 225 OLB**

Part of a Skyhawk defense which ranked second in the OVC in total defense. Look bigger than 225. Two-year starter. 2016 Stats: 48 TT, 9.5 TFL, 5 Sacks, INT, 3 QBH

**Jack Crain** *Dayton* **6-2 225 OLB ILB**

Crain has played in every game for the last three years (34 games). In that time he has accumulated 216 tackles, including a career high of 105 in 2015. This success led Crain to a be Second Team All-PFL Selection in 2016 as well as earning two First Team Academic All-PFL honors. Stats: 79 TT, 6.5 TFL, 2.5 Sacks, INT, 2 PBU, 2 QBH, 2 BKs

**George Dawson** *Fordham* **6-2 225 OLB**

2nd Team All-Patriot. A starter at strong side linebacker in 2016, made 70 total tackles, 50 solo, both team-highs. Included in his 70 stops were nine for loss (39 yards) and 3.5 sacks (18 yards). He also tied for the team lead with three interceptions and was second on the squad with nine pass breakups. Dawson, who also recorded two forced fumbles and recovered one fumble, tied for third in the Patriot League in interceptions, was 14th in tackles for loss and 16th in tackles/game. Over his career, Dawson recorded 223 total tackles, 151 solo, including 24.5 for loss and 6.5 sacks. He also had five interceptions and 18 pass breakups.

**Jalen Day Howard 6-0 220 OLB**

Team's leading tackler. Hard-playing LB who kept concentration despite team's poor performance. 2016 Stats: 75 TT, 6.5 TFL, 4 PBU

**Pierre Gee-Tucker North Dakota State 6-1 225 OLB ILB**

HM All MVC, two year starter at LB and a solid special teamer. 2016 Stats: 75 TT, 8 TFL, 3 Sacks, 5 QBH

**Chad Geter Gardner-Webb 6-3 253 OLB ILB**

Earned his fourth All-America team honor this postseason, making him the first linebacker in Gardner-Webb's football history to do so in the same season. He is the seventh Gardner-Webb standout – regardless of position – to earn spots on four or more teams in a single season and first since 2013. The graduate student earned honors after collecting a career-high 118 total tackles (67 solo) to lead a young, but talented, Gardner-Webb defensive unit in 2016. He added 8.0 tackles for loss, one sack and a team-high six quarterback pressures in 11 games. Geter ranked No. 8 nationally in solo stops among NCAA Division I FCS tacklers and ranked No. 13 nationally in tackles per game. He was even better against top competition, averaging a team-high 12.3 hits against three ranked opponents, collecting a season-high 14 stops against No. 15 Citadel (9/17) and No. 15 Coastal Carolina (10/15). He finished with 10 stops in Gardner-Webb's win at No. 8 Charleston Southern (11/5). Geter closed the 2016 season with six consecutive games of at least 10 tackles. He was runner up for Big South Conference Defensive Player of the Year honors and was one of 25 finalists for the 2016 Buck Buchanan Award, given annually to the top defensive player in FCS. The performance in his final season capped a strong career for the outside linebacker. Geter was a three-time All-Big South Conference choice (2013, 2015, 2016) and finished his career with 345 total tackles and 40 tackles for loss. His total tackles are tied for former All-America linebacker Jeffery Williams for seventh in Big South history and ninth in Gardner-Webb's program record book.

**LeGrande Harley NC Central 6-1 230 OLB**

2nd All MEAC, placed third on the Eagles with 67 tackles, including 6.5 stops behind the line of scrimmage. 2016 Stats: 73 TT, 8 TFL, Sack, INT

**Najee Harris Wagner 6-1 225 OLB**

Co-captain in 2016, is an athletic, battle-tested performer . 2016 Stats: 44 TT, 4.5 TFL, Sack, INT, 5 PBU, 4 QBH, FR

**Marcus Harvey William & Mary 6-2 215 OLB**

Started all 11 games. Led the team with 5.5 TFL. Also totaled 53 tackles, 3 PBU and a half sack. Posted a season-high eight tackles with a half sack at New Hampshire. Recorded seven tackles at NC State. Registered six tackles and a TFL in the win at No. 25 Stony Brook. Tallied five tackles and a TFL at No. 7/6 James Madison and versus Maine. Totaled four tackles, a TFL and a PBU in the victory against Delaware. 2016 Stats: 53 TT, 5.5 TFL, 3 PBU

**Nic Henson San Diego 6-1 220 OLB ILB**

Air Force transfer, 1st All Pioneer, In 2015 was named All-PFL Honorable Mention and to the PFL Honor Roll. Plays hard and smart. Good natural ability and instincts. 2016 Stats: 56 TT, 7 TFL, 2 Sacks, 2 PBU, FR

**Syd Holt Campbell 6-4 225 OLB**

1st All Pioneer, helped lead the nation's 17th ranked defense (322.1 yards per game), totaling 40 tackles with 10.5 going for loss. The redshirt senior added 5.0 sacks, recovered two fumbles and blocked a kick in 2016. He was one of eight in the PFL with at least 10.5 tackles for loss and 5.0 sacks.

**Justin Horton Jacksonville 6-2 235 OLB**

Outside linebacker, earned Second-Team All-PFL with 70 tackles, six TFL, and 4.5 sacks. Had 36 solo tackles, three quarterback hurries, two forced fumbles, and one recovery. He also rushed one fake punt for 33 yards. Horton concluded his career with 120 tackles, 12 TFL, and 7.5 sacks.

**Jonathan Jackson Murray State 5-11 215 OLB**

Undersized LB with a great motor and football I.Q. Stats: 69 TT, 7 TFL, 2 Sacks, 4 PBU, 4 QBH, 2 FF

**Richard Jarvis Brown 6-2 225 OLB**

1st All Ivy as a DE, led the Ivy League and ranked ninth nationally in tackles for a loss with 18.5, and ranked 24th nationally in forced fumbles. He started 20 straight games for the Bears and had 101 career tackles. Jarvis made 65 total tackles, including 40 solo stops in 2016. He was the top defensive player on the field against Ivy co-champion Penn, constantly penetrating the line of scrimmage, making 3.5 tackles for a loss of 15 yards, including two quarterback sacks for a loss of 12 yards. Stats: 65 TT, 18.5 TFL, 7.5 Sacks, 5 PBU, 5 QBH, 3 FF

**Byron Johnson Furman 6-2 225 OLB**

Verstile defender who played strong safety as a junior. Has also played middle linebacker and outside. 2016 Stats: 71 TT, 2.5 TFL, Sack, 2 INTs, 2 PBU, 2 QBH

**Jawon Johnson North Dakota 6-2 215 OLB**

Saw action at both safety and outside linebacker during his career. 2016 Stats: 44 TT, 3 TFL, Sack, 4 QBH

**Javancy Jones Jackson State 6-2 245 OLB DE**

3rd Stats FCS All American, 2nd AFCA All American, Boxtorow All American (2x), 1st All SWAC (DL), 2nd (LB), finished the regular season 2nd in the SWAC in tackles for loss (19.5), 3rd in total tackles (82) and 12th in sacks (4). He was also 9th in the league in forced fumbles. Was also a finalist for the C Spire Conerly Trophy (most outstanding player in the state of Mississippi), All-SWAC as a DE and LB in the same season. 2016 Stats: 82 TT, 19.5 TFL, 4 Sacks, PBU, 2 QBH, FR, 2 FF, 2 rcp-TD

**Antonio Justice, Jr Tennessee State 6-1 225 OLB**

Third on the team with 53 tackles playing 11 games at linebacker, starting eight. Made 35 solo tackles, 3.0 for loss, three quarterback hurries and three pass breakups. Recorded season highs in tackles (8), TFL's (1.5), sacks (1.0) and forced fumbles (1) at Austin Peay (11/5) 2016 Stats: 53 TT, 3 TFL, Sack, 3 PBU, 3 QBH, FR, FF

**Christian Kuntz Duquesne 6-1 230 OLB ILB**

1st Stats FCS All American, 2nd AP All American, 2nd AFCA All American, Walter Camp All America, 1st All NEC (DPOY), was on the STATS FCS Buck Buchanan Award Watch List (top defensive player in the FCS), finished his career as the conference's all-time leading sack leader with 30.5. Led the NEC in sacks (11.5) and tackles for loss (24.0) this season. 2016 Stats: 64 TT, 24 TFL, 11.5 Sacks, 2 PBU, 7 QBH, FR, 3 FF

**Brian Labat North Dakota 6-3 235 OLB ILB**

HM All Big Sky, three-year starter. Very active LB with good football IQ. 2nd Team All-Big Sky 2015. 2016 Stats: 40 TT, 8 TFL, 2 Sacks, 2 INTs, 4 PBU, 4 QBH

**David Lazear Stetson 5-11 210 OLB SS**

Four year starter. Helped resurrect the Stetson football program after a 55 year absence as one of the original signees. 2016 Stats: 71 TT, 17 TFL, 5.5 Sacks, PBU, 4 QBH, 2 FR, FF

**Darnell Leslie Monmouth (NJ) 6-2 235 OLB ILB**

2nd All Big South, his second All-Big South honor after finishing second among conference defensive linemen in tackles with 72. Finished second in the league with two fumble recoveries and third in forced fumbles (2). Leslie finished seventh in the league in tackles for a loss with 10 and recorded a career-high 14 tackles in his final game at Gardner-Webb. He ended his career sixth all-time in sacks with 15.0 in three seasons with the Blue & White. The fifth-year senior started every game at defensive end after missing 2015 with an injury sustained in preseason. 2016 Stats: 72 TT, 10 TFL, 3 Sacks, 2 QBH, 2 FR, 2 FF

**Abner Logan Albany (NY) 6-1 235 OLB**

Transfer from Maryland, who in 2015 suffered a season-ending injury in preseason camp and transferred to Albany. Was the No. 3 player in Massachusetts and the No. 35 outside linebacker in the class of 2012, Maryland's best under head coach Randy Edsall. Albany's 2nd leading tackler in 2016. Attended the 2017 Regional Combine in Virginia. One scout noted that has an explosive first step and is quick off the snap, Apparently, Logan is even handed as he displayed great balance and power coming off the bags during his Pass Rush Drills, both left and right, and shined with his catching ability while finishing his Back Pedal Drill off a catch.

**Darius Manora Yale 6-0 235 OLB**

HM All Ivy, Captain senior year. Played in all 40 games over four seasons. 219 tackles with 5.5 sacks. 2016: Started every game at linebacker. Third on team in total tackles with 63. Made 1.5 sacks. 2016 Stats: 63 TT, 6 TFL, 1.5 Sacks

**Anthony McNichols Portland State 5-11 235 OLB**

**Jeremy Miles NC Central 6-1 230 OLB**

Voted to Preseason All-MEAC First Team. Announced to Preseason BOXTOROW All-America Team, honoring the top players from HBCUs. 2016 Stats: 42 TT, 4 TFL, Sack

**Mike Needham** *Southern Utah* **6-4 215 OLB**

1st All Big Sky, led the team in tackles with 76, adding nine tackles for loss and three sacks. Needham also led the team in interceptions with five. 2016 Stats: 76 TT, 9 TFL, 3 Sacks, 5 INTs, 8 PBU, FF. JR/SR

**Michael Nicastro** *Albany (NY)* **5-10 225 OLB**

Grad Student, First-Team All-CAA Defense. With 126 tackles on the season, Nicastro led the CAA and tied for fourth in the FCS, averaging 11.5 tackles per game. Starting all 11 games, Nicastro also led the conference and ranked third in the nation with three fumbles recovered, while also recording three interceptions. In just three full seasons on the gridiron, Nicastro finished is career ranked fifth all-time in UAlbany's record book with 310 career tackles.

**Phil Novacki** *Georgetown* **6-4 255 OLB DE**

Played both DE and OLB. Two-time Academic All-Patriot League Team. He finished his senior season with a team-high 6.5 sacks and ranked second with 7.5 TFL to go along with 37 tackles, including 19 solo takedowns. 2nd All Big South, hard nose LB with a great motor and intensity. 2016 Stats: 72 TT, 4 TFL, INT, 2 PBU, 2 BKs

**Khari Rosier** *Presbyterian* **6-3 230 OLB**



2nd All Big South as a DE, capped off his career with a standout senior campaign, recording 63 tackles on the season, most by a defensive lineman in PC's Division I era. The defensive end also tallied 8.0 tackles for loss and 3.0 sacks on the season, pushing his career totals to 24.0 and 9.5, respectively, both of which rank fourth on PC's Division I career lists. He finished third in the Big South in tackles by a defensive lineman and second in the category in league games. Established a new career-high with 13 tackles against Kennesaw State on November 12, the most tackles by a PC player in a game this season.
